REGULAR SESSION

The Muhlenberg Township Trustees met in regular session on January 9, 2023 at the Township House from 7:00 p.m. to 9:19 p.m. Jeff Wippel called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

- ✓ The following resolution 2023-01 passed on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2023, by three yeas after a roll call vote.

Be It Resolved by the board of Muhlenberg Township, of Pickaway County that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Board of Muhlenberg Township, during the fiscal year, ending December 31, 2023, the following sums be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during said fiscal year, as follows,

General Fund	203,785.32
Motor Vehicle Fund	40,836.98
Gasoline Fund	425,765.33
Road and Bridge Fund	227,578.67
Cemetery Fund	254,561.19
Fire/EMS Fund	289,742.49

The trustees signed the 2023 purchase orders and blanket certificates.

The trustees reviewed the 2023 contract with the Southwest Pickaway Fire District. Jeff Wippel moved, seconded by Stan Summers to accept the contract in the amount of \$6,600.00. Motion passed with three yeas.

The trustees, while doing road checks noticed that more gravel is needed on Darby Road near Ron Shipley's property in the turnaround used by the USPS. Jeff Wippel moved, seconded by Stan Summers to purchase a load of gravel from Westfall Ag to take care of the issue. Motion passed with two votes, one abstain.

Steve Garner addressed the trustees about HB#501 and asked that the bill be review by the trustees. Mr. Garner also asked if the trustees would have an interest in setting aside a small area for a monument for a local Civil War drummer boy.

Being there was no further business to discuss, Ronald Clifton moved, seconded by Stan Summers to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed by three yeas.
